The Lighting of the Advent Candles and Preparation of the Cradle

Reader 1: This is the second Sunday in Advent, the time of preparing for the coming of Christ our Savior. Today our word is *prepare*. Not only do we wait for our Savior, but we use this time of waiting creatively. We prepare for Christmas with gift purchases, tree trimming, home decorating and card sending. We prepare for Christ with prayer, quiet time and commitments to be better people.

Reader 2: (Reading Isaiah 40:1-5)

Reader 1: We light the first Advent candle, remembering that we wait for Christ. We also light today's candle, remembering that we must prepare our hearts for Christ's coming.

Reader 2: Let us pray. Gracious God, help us to prepare not only our homes but also our hearts and lives for the coming of Emmanuel. Let us make our way straight, that Christ may come to us in the fullness of time, as we wait and prepare a place in our lives. Amen.

Prayer of Confession (unison): Silent Word, Creative Act, Hidden Truth, Revealed Love: we wait for you. To be precise, we are impatient for you to come and set things right. We seldom pause to consider that you are waiting for us; waiting for us to listen and respond with a burning passion for your truth, your justice and your mercy. Forgive us, Lord, for our casual faith. Forgive us for assuming we know your ways. Forgive us for thinking that love is a small thing reserved for those we like. Mend us, God of the Straight Way, and turn us back to you.
